Professionals should use Adobe's professional digital imaging products — including Photoshop — for creating digital images and videos for publishing or marketing. For the tasks that professionals perform with these tools, Photoshop is simply the best choice. I recommend that, as a first project, you perform important tasks using Photoshop. PhotoShop Elements PhotoShop Elements is the free version of Photoshop, covering the same features. It lacks some of the more sophisticated features of Photoshop, but it does have a few strengths that make it a viable alternative. PhotoShop Elements has a similar layer-based editing system to that of Photoshop, enabling you to create and edit one image at a time. Elements does have a number of predesigned templates, but it doesn't provide tools for quick image resizing or adjustments, such as brightness, contrast, and sharpening. At the time of this writing, Elements also lacks some of the advanced features that are available in Photoshop. For example, it doesn't support Adobe LiveMotion, Advanced Photomerge, or Content-Aware Fill. But if you find that elements doesn't cut it for you, you can upgrade to the Professional version of the product, which is certainly worth the additional \$240 for more advanced tools. Upgrading to Elements You can upgrade from a Free plan to a Professional version of Elements, but you can't upgrade to the Professional version from the Free version. You need to purchase the first version of Elements that you wish to upgrade to the professional version, and then upgrade it to the Professional version. If you are stuck between one program and the other, and you really don't know which one would be best suited to your needs, consider upgrading to the Professional version of Elements as your first tool. Manipulating and Applying Effects You can apply two types of effects in Photoshop: using textures and applying effects. The first way is much easier. You apply textured effects to create grunge, faux finishes, and other effects. You apply any color or other effects simply by changing the color with the paint bucket. The second method — applying effects — is a little bit more complicated. You manipulate an image layer to create different effects, and you can apply those effects to the entire image. The following sections show you how to apply the effects that you see on this book's pages in Photoshop. Texturing your image Texturing provides quick access to grunge and fancy finishes that you can apply to

The app has advanced features like layers, selection, text, filters, merging, and adjustment tools. It is also available for Android and iOS devices. One of the new features in its updated version is the “Selective Color” tool. It lets you pick your favorite colors from the picture and apply them to other areas of the photo. So, if you're a photographer who uses Photoshop to edit photos, you should definitely take a look at how to use the Selective Color tool in Photoshop Elements. So, how does the tool work? Let's get started with the tutorial. How to Use the Selective Color Tool in Photoshop Elements This amazing tool can be found in the tools palette, where you can also check out the Magic Brush and other tools. I'll walk you through the steps of how to use this tool: To open the tool, go to the tools palette. You can start by pressing spacebar or the “+” button, depending on your version. Press G to go to the selection tool. Click on the Ellipse tool. This tool resembles a circle with an oval on its center. Select the Oval Ellipse tool by pressing the E key. Once you've selected the tool, release it and press S to save the selection. You can learn more about the selection tools here. Go to the Selective Color tool. This tool has a small box in the top-right corner of the tool. Click and drag this box around parts of the image you want to color. For example, you can click the box over a face and apply a color to it, and just move the box away from any uncolored spots. At this point, you should have some colors in the box. Now you need to copy and paste those colors from the box. For this, select the source and destination colors from the dialog box. You can find those options in the tools palette. If you have a few similar colors, you can sort them in the Color and Lighting panel of the palette. The Color and Lighting panel can be opened by clicking the “A” button. Then, you can drag these colors to other locations in the image. Once you've finished coloring the image, you can use the “Clear the color box” option in the tools palette.
